### **Bulk Trash, Junk Hauling, Medication Disposal**

*For safe and proper removal of unwanted and donation inappropriate items:*

CHV Hazardous Waste Pick Up – Service Available to Members – Occurs First Saturday of each month. Hazardous materials and personal papers will be picked up from CHV members' homes for delivery to the District's safe disposal site. Hazardous wastes for pickup include documents to be shredded, house cleaners, batteries, televisions, computers and their accessories, video equipment, and other items not accepted in weekly home trash pickup. To sign up for this service, call the office at **202-543-1778**

DC Department of Public Works – Bulk Trash Pick Up - **(202) 737-4404** - Service can handle up to seven (7) large items in a pre-scheduled bulk trash pick-up for DC residents. Medication disposal - Safe and proper disposal will lessen the risk of people consuming or handling medications inappropriately or illegally and will prevent medications from entering the water supply and harming aquatic life. For an at-home solution, mix the remaining medications in coffee grinds or cat litter, place in a sealable container, and put in the regular trash. There are a handful of pharmacies that accept medications in a return tub on site. The closest one to Capitol Hill is located near Mt. Vernon Square:
