In reality, not all LGBT elders are famous politicians or celebrities. They are notable because they simply have and continued to exist at a time when they faced intentional efforts towards their eradication.

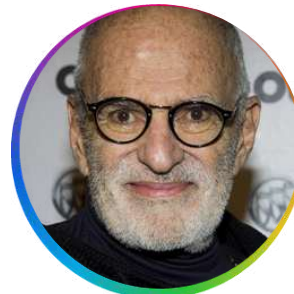
