

## LGBT Elders Day: Book Recommendations From Former CHV Intern Elliot Pinch



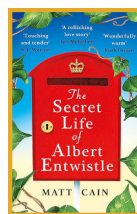
### **Never Silent: ACT UP and My Life in Activism, By: Peter Staley**

Albert's life changes forever when after years working as a postman, he is forced to retire. Follow him as he tries to reconnect with his friends, himself, and long lost lover.



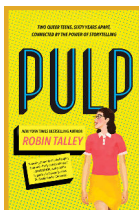
### **Mrs. Martin's Incomparable Adventure, By: Courtney Milan**
